SRP Pool Party!

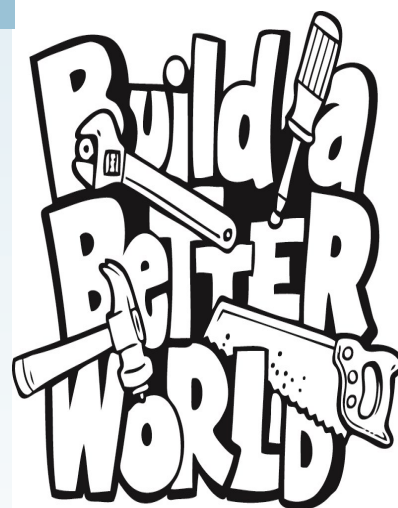
