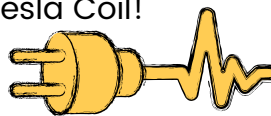

Copies in regular print, large print, and audiobooks are available in the library. A book discussion will be held Monday, August 1, at 6:30 p.m. on the main level of the library.



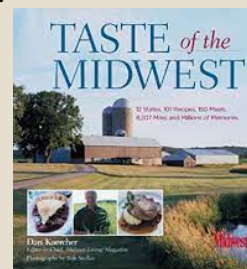
SUMMERTIME AT WPL

Hello there! Summer reading is halfway through, and the library is so happy to see all your smiling faces.

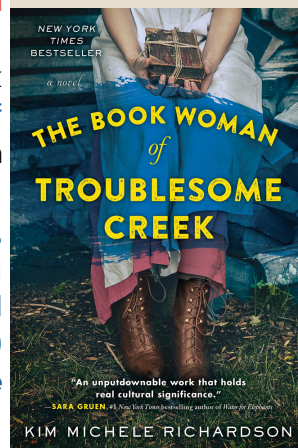

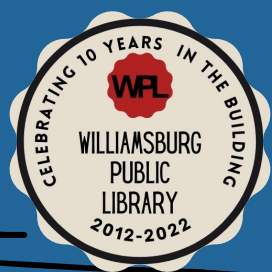
