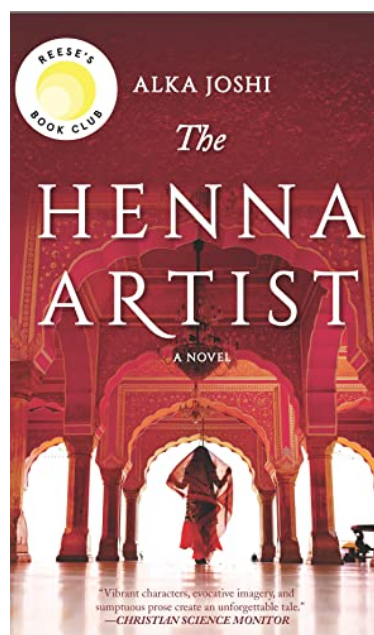
KEEP SUMMER READING GOING:
