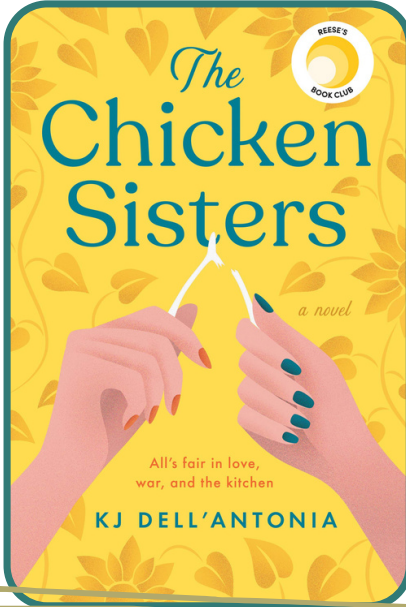
BOOK ENDS BOOK CLUB

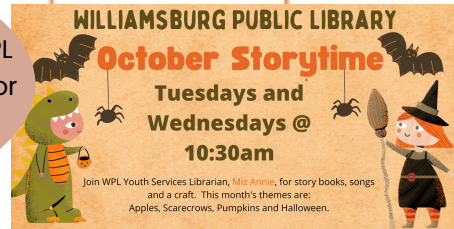
