
Copies in regular print, large print, and audiobooks are available in the library. A book discussion will be held on Monday, November 7th at 6:30 p.m. on the library's main level.

Fall into a good recipe this October by participating in Cook the Book. Come into the library, pick out a recipe from month's theme cookbooks, and prepare the recipe for all to try!




#### FALL AT WILLIAMSBURG PUBLIC LIBRARY
