

Based on true-life events that took place in the Manitoba Colony, a remote Mennonite community Bolivia. in Between 2005 and 2009, over a hundred girls and women in the colony woke up to discover that they had been raped in their sleep. Toews' novel centers on the secret meetings of eight Mennonite women who, on behalf of the other women in the colony, must decide how to react to these traumatic events. They have only 48 hours before the colony men, who are away to post bail for the rapists, return.
