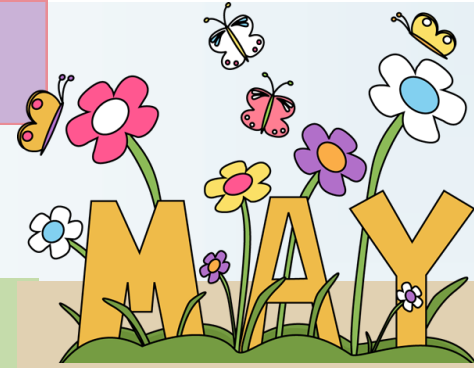


# The Burg Stacks


